## STATE OF EMERGENCY: Day 22

- We continue to hear that Coxen Hole is busy. Traffic needs to be reduced in Coxen Hole
- Only **1 person per household** can circulate for essential errands on their **assigned day**.
- **Face Masks** will be mandatory starting tomorrow, **7-APR-2020** gloves are recommended but not mandatory at this time except at supermarkets. Gloves can be purchased at Pharmacies and at supermarkets.
- Delivery services have restarted with supermarkets.
